## FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT



Immaculate Conception School in Bellevue is now enrolling for the 2020-2021 school year. We are accepting students for preschool through grade 8. Tuition scholarships are also available. Some of those are local scholarships (Northwest Ohio Scholarship Fund and Father Bishop Tuition Assistance). Others are offered by the state: EdChoice Expansion--based on the family's income, and Traditional EdChoice--based solely on where the student resides. This is only for new students to ICS. If the school district and specific school that the child resides in is one of 1200 schools that are included on the EdChoice Eligibility list, that child is eligible to have tuition paid in full for their entire school career. *This list includes many of our local school districts.* The entire list can be viewed on the ODE website. These are all great opportunities to assist you in paying for your child's education. Cost should not be a determining factor in choosing ICS.

At this point, Kindergarten Screening at ICS has been postponed. Please check the bulletin or school website for updates.

If you have any questions about ICS or would like to schedule a tour, please call the school. Come visit and see what we have to offer. We want to work with you to have your child be a part of the Saints' Family.
