MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Christ's peace to all on this 24 th Sunday of Ordinary Time!

The Lord's patience and mercy defies human reasoning. Despite the punishment that Israel rightly earned for their bad behavior following their exile from Egypt, God "relents" from executing punishment at the passionate plea of Moses. Paul speaks candidly and passionately about his own ignorance as a Pharisee and his violent persecution of others--actions that made him deserving of also. Yet as a "foremost" among sinners, Paul is treated with great mercy by God and even entrusted with the great mission of "Apostle."

Jesus goes on with three familiar parables in the Gospel today. No person in their 'right mind' would abandon a flock of ninety-nine sheep to search for one lost soul; or having lost one coin ,tear the house apart looking for it; or, having been abandoned by a selfish child who presumptuously took his inheritance and squandered it in a way that smeared the family name, would welcome him home so readily with open arms and joy! We would simply write such things off as a loss and lesson learned, yet God's love far transcends our lack of it in our selfishness.

While most people may not be quick to forgive our sins and mistakes, God is! He desires repentance, always extending his hand in friendship, but we must respond by taking his hand! This means going to confession regularly (not just once or twice a year). This means throwing ourselves down at the feet of our heavenly Father and recognizing that our life, is a mess and that we need him in it!
