**MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR**

Christ's peace to all on this 23rd Sunday of Ordinary Time!

Today Jesus is surrounded by "great crowds." We can imagine how so many were enamored by the figure of Jesus – his teaching, his miracles, his direct style that seemed to challenge the establishment. Everyone wanted to follow him, and yet, when we arrive at the Cross, we know that there were so very few who remained with the Lord.

Here we come to the great price of discipleship: "If anyone comes to me without hating his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple."

We are called to love God above all things, and then to love everything else for God's sake. But we often fall prey to loving everything else first to the exclusion of God. Jesus is God, and to be his disciple, there is no middle ground. If we are not willing to place our love and loyalty to him before all else, even before good things like our family, we will not be found standing beneath the cross, and will not be found worthy as disciples who will inherit the divine life.
